Hey everyone,

I have some important news about our campground. As we wrap up another great season, I want to let you know about some changes we have made and some exciting developments that are coming up.

For seasonal campers, we have a special offer for you. If you plan on spending up to three nights every weekend, the cost for the season will be \$3,000. If you cannot pay in full, you can pay in monthly installments of \$700, which will total \$3,500 for the season. If you want to stay longer than the allotted time, each additional night will cost \$70.

If you plan on living here full-time and staying for four to seven nights, the cost will be \$4,000 for the season. If you cannot pay in full, you can pay \$1,200 monthly, totaling \$4,500 for the season.

Please note that these rates cannot be booked online. Personal checks should be mailed to Marv Thomann, and he can provide more information if needed.

We also have a new option for month-to-month camping. You can rent a spot for \$800 per month, which includes four weekends. The rental period will be from the first of the month to the 30th.

Please keep in mind that <u>no glass containers</u> should be transported from one campsite to another. You can have glass inside your camper, but please be careful.

Also, we would prefer non-smokers stay at our campground. If you smoke, please do it in your own property with the windows up, and make sure no one else can smell it.

And please, do not walk into Marv's office if you smell like smoke.

As of 2024, we will no longer have porta-potties. Fiberoptic internet will be available, Party Central will have its own bathroom, and Richy Rich will have his brand-new cabin.

We are also expanding by putting up a 50x100 building for storage, which will make more space available for our seasonal campers who need to store their belongings.
